How to get there

Reconfirmation requirements

Please be advised you are required to contact The Service Provider 24 hours prior to the travel date during business hours to reconfirm your booking, pick up location and time, and departure time with your confirmation number. Please adjust your travel plan according to the details given by The Service Provider at time of reconfirming.

Check-in requirements

- For all hotel/motel pick ups: please arrive 10 minutes prior to the pick-up time at your booked pick up location. There might be 5-10 minutes delay depends on the traffic on the day. If you think the pick is late or you are not being picked up, please call The Service Provider and quote your confirmation number to double check.
- For Adelaide Central Bus Station pick ups: please ensure you arrive at the Adelaide Sightseeing Counter 30 minutes before your scheduled departure time to allow enough time to check in. Passengers that fail to arrive before this time may be classed as no-show.

Kangaroo Island is a Ligurian Bee Sanctuary. Importing honey, pollen or other bee products is prohibited. A fine of up to \$10,000 may apply. Please help protect Kangaroo Island and keep it safe from pests and diseases. Do not bring any bee or honey products, unwashed potatoes, vine cuttings, foxes or rabbits onto the island. Penalties may apply. Kangaroo Island Council must be notified by the owner of any dogs or cats visiting the island. Please contact their Customer Service Centre on 8553 4500. - Minimum passengers for departure: 4 Adults. If minimum is not meet, tour is subject to cancel.

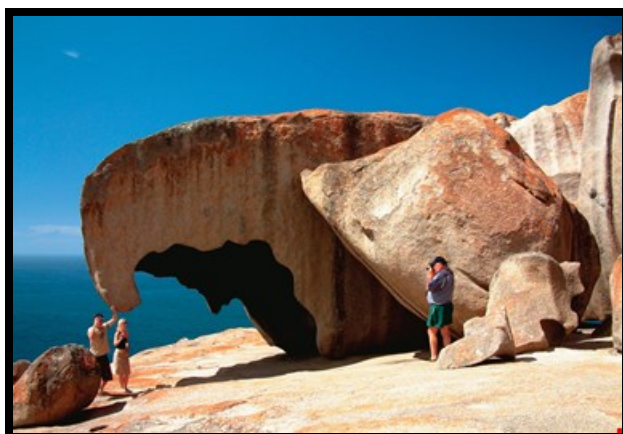
[Important Post-Covid Service Information]

- To enter and exit the vehicle, passengers are encouraged to load from the back first, and to exit from the front. Social distance should be adhered to at all times while waiting on or off vehicle.
- During travel, passengers are asked to remain in the same seat for the entirety of their journey and to avoid walking up and down the aisle as well as refrain from touching headrests as they move through the vehicle.

See the highlights of South Australia's premier nature-based tourism destination, Kangaroo Island. From Remarkable Rocks to playful fur seals, SealLink guides will take you to the Kangaroo Island's natural highlights. This is simply the best 1 Day Kangaroo Island tour available.

Take a guided walk on the beach among a colony of rare and wild Australian sea lions with a National Parks Ranger at Seal Bay Conservation Park. Get up close and see these wild creatures frolic and laze about – a truly amazing and unforgettable experience.

Then enjoy a delicious two course lunch at Vivonne Bay Bistro, located on the south coast of Kangaroo Island.

Spend some of the afternoon in the Flinders Chase National Park, which was devastated in the worst fire to ever hit the island in January 2020. You'll see that the regeneration of the native bush occurs so quickly after the event and there will be many opportunities to take photos. As you travel through the park, keep an eye out for echidnas, wallabies, reptiles, and koalas. See the rugged coastline from walks around Remarkable Rocks and Admirals Arch. Remarkable Rocks provide great photographic opportunities, and the Admirals Arch boardwalk takes you down a rugged cliff face to reveal the spectacular rock archway, a natural nursery and safe haven for playful Long-nosed Fur Seals.

Your last visit of the day is to the Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park to feed some kangaroos and get up close to the Kangaroo Island Koalas while listening to the Keeper talk about the cuddly mammals. There is also a possibility that you will see more kangaroos and wallabies on your return to Penneshaw for your return ferry and coach transfer back to Adelaide.

Highlights

- **Seal Bay Conservation Park (beach walk amongst the Australian sea lions)**
Seal Bay is the home of the Australian sea lion and the third largest breeding colony in Australia. You will have the opportunity to see these creatures close-up, swimming in the surf or basking in the sand. Seal Bay is a conservation park and you will be taken down onto the beach by a Parks Interpretative Officer. Take your camera with you, as this is a unique opportunity to walk on the beach with these animals.
- **Vivonne Bay Bistro (lunch)**
Enjoy a delicious two course lunch (main and dessert) at Vivonne Bay Bistro, located on the south coast of Kangaroo Island.
- **Flinders Chase National Park**
Spend the afternoon in the Flinders Chase National Park, which was devastated by the worst fire to ever hit the island in January 2020. You'll see that the regeneration of the native bush occurs so quickly after the event and there will be many opportunities to take photos. As you travel through the park, keep an eye out for echidnas, wallabies, reptiles, and koalas.
- **Remarkable Rocks**
Remarkable Rocks are a cluster of granite boulders, sculpted by the weather and perched on a granite dome rising steeply from the ocean. You can take a walk around these huge rocks that have been carved into many different weird and wonderful shapes by the wind and the ocean spray over many centuries. Please be very careful and do not go beyond the 'Danger' signs. Winds can be very strong and the rocks are slippery when wet.
- **Admirals Arch**
A steep, but short walk from Cape du Couedic lighthouse is a spectacular natural Arch formed by erosion from the pounding sea. This area is the breeding ground of a colony of Long-nosed Fur Seals. You will see them frolicking in the water and on the rocks under the Arch. Please take care when walking down to the Arch as the winds can be very strong and the path slippery. Please do not leave the pathway.
- **Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park (guided tour to see kangaroos and koalas)**
The Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park is located in the heartland of Kangaroo Island. Here you will be taken on a short guided tour to walk amongst kangaroos and wallabies where you'll have the opportunity to hand feed them. You'll also get up close to the Kangaroo Island koalas while listening to the keeper talk about the cuddly mammals.
